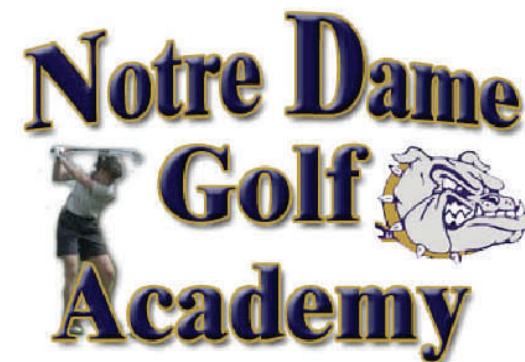

Equipment

Academy students are not required to own golf clubs but it is proven to be more effective if they have their own for various reasons.



Tuition

The cost of each academy will be \$95.00/month or \$900.00/year if paid in one payment. The school sports academies will be operated on a cost recovery basis.



This program is intended for highly motivated students who wish to significantly advance their golf skills and knowledge of the game. A very high standard will be set with regard to behavior and a willingness to meet this level will be the basis for advancing through the program. Students who fail to meet behavior expectation will be directed to programs that better meet their needs at the discretion of the Program Instructors.

AREAS OF INSTRUCTION *(2 times a week)*

- ◇ Golf Related Fitness Training
- ◇ Golf Equipment (terminology, selection, etc.)
- ◇ Golf Course Etiquette and Rules of Golf.
- ◇ Swing Technique (Putting, Chipping, Full Swing).
- ◇ Hands-on practice and playing sessions (at Cottonwood Coulee Golf Course, Ross Creek Golf Club, and other locations).
- ◇ Practice Techniques
- ◇ Course Management and Strategies of the Game.
- ◇ Video analysis
- ◇ Goal Setting (journals, etc)
- ◇ Alberta Physical Education and Health curriculum will be covered throughout the year
- ◇ Alternate Activities (There will be a variety offered throughout the year)
