- What is the most difficult thing about living in Canada?

Naturally to communicate is one of the hardest things. I want to say what I think, but sometimes I'm frustrated that I don't know how to say it, and sometimes I get upset because I don't understand what the other person is saying.

However, I'm doing my best in school and I believe one day there will be a day when I can talk to others without any problems.

- What should foreigners do when they come to Korea? Or what is the merits of Korea?

I think when they come to Korea, I want to tell them to experience Korean food first.

Korean food is really delicious and once you eat it, you will keep thinking about it.

And even if you deliver food to your house or anywhere late at night, it is really convenient to come there in 10 to 15 minutes. Also I think it would be nice for foreigners to see Korean buildings, especially the really cool traditional palace.

The merits of Korea is fast networking (developed IT technology), delicious food, convenient facilities, health care, K-pop, safety, kind people, etc.

- What are differences in culture between Korea and Canada?

All Korean schools are divided equally into elementary school (grade 1~6 for 6 years), middle school (grade 7~9 for 3 years), high school (grade 10~12 for 3 years) and university. In addition, there are no school busses, we stay in the homeroom and the teachers move when the class changes, all students have 4 big exams for all subjects in one year, the school offers lunch (some high schools offer dinner to the students because they have to study until night in school), we wear specific uniforms of the school and we don't inherit the textbook.
